### Abstract Requirements:

- All abstract submissions are required to be structured under these headings:
  - Title,
  - Author(s)/Company/Institution,
  - Purpose,
  - Methods,
  - Results,
  - and Conclusions.
- The size of the abstract must be limited to 300 words or less and fit within one 8.5" x 11" page. Submit the Microsoft Word Abstract by e-mail to [marisol.perez@excipientfest.com](mailto:marisol.perez@excipientfest.com) on or before March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2012. Authors may include tables and or graphics as long as the abstract does not exceed the 8.5" x 11" page limitation. Tables and graphics must be embedded into the abstract text.

### Important Deadlines to Remember:

- March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2012 (Fri.)**  
Deadline for submission of poster topic & abstract.
- April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2012 (Fri.)**  
Deadline to receive posters at ExcipientFest office if authors not attending Conference.

### Abstract and Poster Submission Procedure:

- After submission of the poster topic and abstract, authors will be informed of acceptance status by April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2012.
- Authors who are not able to attend ExcipientFest must submit final poster by courier to Marisol Perez at the following address: **ExcipientFest, Inc. / Carr. 172 Km. 14.5 Ave. El Jibaro, Edif. Pharmaparc, Cidra, PR - 00739**. Posters have to be received at ExcipientFest office on or before April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2012.
- Authors attending ExcipientFest will bring their posters to ExcipientFest and will be responsible for mounting and dismounting.

### Poster Guidelines:

- All posters will be displayed during both days of ExcipientFest. Posters will be set-up and completely dismantled by authors. If author is not able to attend, ExcipientFest will be responsible for the mounting and dismounting of poster. Poster set-up: April 23<sup>rd</sup> (Monday) 4:00PM-10:00PM / April 24<sup>th</sup> (Tuesday) 6:00AM-10:00AM. Poster take-down: April 25<sup>th</sup> (Wednesday) after 6:00PM.
- Bring only items that can be mounted on poster board. No electrical projection capabilities will be available. All items for posting must be prepared in advance. Graphic supplies will not be available.
- Poster board is 6 feet wide by 4 feet high. Mounting surface (usable space) is 5'10" wide by 3'10" high (8'x4' available upon request). You are responsible for supplying your own materials for mounting posters. Do not use tape or other adhesive materials, or write/mark the poster board. Thumb tacks or pins allowed.
- Assigned numbers will be displayed in the upper corner of each poster board by ExcipientFest. Put your poster in the space with the number assigned to you.
